Avalanche rescue equipment must be carried (beacon, shovel, probe and pack) and is available to rent for JPY 12,000 for the duration of the Detour.

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Itinerary

Day 1 (20th Jan)

Arrival at Chitose Airport: A bus company representative will be waiting to assist you to the Niseko resort bus transfer service. We'll meet you in person on arrival at the Niseko Welcome Center and take you to your accommodation.

Day 2 (21st Jan)

Meet the crew for a leisurely morning coffee, then off to find your legs again as you begin to explore Niseko. The afternoon will include a short avalanche beacon training session.

Day 3 to Day 7 (22nd to 26th)

Four out of five days of exploring Niseko's surrounding resorts (includes a contingency/rest day at some point), with trips to both Rusutsu and Moiwa (our personal favourite), finding the best daily conditions with our top guides/coaches.

Day 8 (27th Jan)

Transfer to our second base in Furano.

Day 9 to Day 11 (28th to 30th Jan)

Three days of exploring the resorts of Furano and Central Hokkaido, including Hokkaido's highest peak Asahidake, finding the best daily conditions with our top guides/coaches.

Day 12 (31st Jan)

After transferring to the city of Sapporo the evening before, we'll spend our last on-snow day exploring the steep secret stashes of Sapporo Teine, then take a look around the famous Sapporo Snow Festival and get a little crazy in the almost-as-famous Sapporo nightlife.

Day 13 (1st Feb)

Transfer to Sapporo Chitose Airport for departures.

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
